

LINK 4 Skills

The LINK project recently conducted its 3rd and final Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) in Sofia, Bulgaria, from October 9th to 10th, 2023. Hosted by Maria's World Foundation, this event brought together 10 participants, with 2 representatives from each of the project's partner countries: Italy, Bulgaria, Lithuania, Spain, and Portugal. This event involved the organization/institution, Maria's World Foundation, with 10 participants representing partner countries.

During this TPM, the partnership had the opportunity to reflect on the work accomplished so far and make plans for the final stages of the project. This event also provided insights into the real-world impact of Maria's World Foundation, including a visit to their daycare center and the chance to meet the young individuals they support. Notably, some of these young people had already engaged with the didactic materials developed within the project, expressing enthusiasm for the learning opportunities it provided.

LINK project infact forsees the creation of a Blended Adult Education Course on digital and employability skills and a handbook on digital and gamified learning activities for young adults with behavioural and cognitive disabilities supporting them in the transition to the job market. The project and the activity itself aligns therefore with one of the four basic priorities of the Erasmus program, which is inclusion. Furthermore, it is linked to the "European Year of the Skills" 2023, as evident from the event's name, "LINK 4SKILLS," and its mission to equip young adults with the necessary skills for the job market.



Additionally, the partnership had the privilege of exploring Sofia's highlights, including the historic Boyana Church and its remarkable story.
